Accordingly, Council concentrates its efforts on the following outputs:

1. The link between the College and Albertans.
2. Demonstrates evidence informed leadership that provides long term, visionary (generative) direction.
3. Written policies which, at the broadest levels, address:
 - 3.1 *Ends*: what good or benefit the organization is to achieve, for which people, at what cost.
 - 3.2 *Executive Limitations*: constraints on executive authority which establish the boundaries of prudence and ethics within which all executive activity and decisions must take place.
 - 3.3 *Governance Process*: how the Council conceives, carries out, and monitors its own task.
 - 3.4 *Council-Registrar Relationship*: how power is delegated and its proper use monitored; the Registrar role, authority, and accountability.
4. Assurance of organizational performance through structured monitoring of the Registrar as outlined in policies on Council-Registrar Relationship.
