Instructions

For each case, write concise statements that provide context to help assessors understand the actions you took, the decisions you made, and the reasons behind them. If additional space is required for any of the questions, attach an additional page and direct assessors to the continued response by recording the appropriate page number (e.g., continued on page CN-3).

Provide an overview of the case. Include background information about the patient that may help the assessors understand the context of the care you provided.

What precipitated the need to develop a care plan for this patient and/or why did the patient approach you for care on this particular occasion?

What were the patient's expectations and goals of therapy?

For each Drug Therapy Problem, consider the following questions and supplement or explain the information that is documented in the patient record, if required.

- Is there additional information about the rationale for your actions or recommendations that is not documented in the portions of the patient record that you have submitted as part of this case?
- What factors led you to choose the treatment that you did?
- What other treatments (pharmacological and non-pharmacological) did you consider?

In most cases, the documentation within the patient record, the supporting information you compile, and your responses above will provide adequate information to assessors about the care you provide. If there is additional information or unique circumstances that you feel is important to explain, state concisely below (optional).
