Emergency Authority Bylaw

The Alberta College of Pharmacy

Definitions

- 1. In this Emergency Authority Bylaw:
 - (a) "Bylaws" means the Bylaws of the Alberta College of Pharmacy;
 - (b) "emergency" means
 - i. a public health emergency under the *Public Health Act*;
 - ii. a state of emergency or state of local emergency under the *Emergency* Management Act; or
 - another unusual or unforeseen circumstance that prevents or limits the College from taking actions, making decisions or conducting elections under the Bylaws.

Council Authority in Emergency

- 2. If, in the Council's opinion, an emergency requires
 - (a) the delaying of an action, the making of a decision or the conduct of an election under the Bylaws, or
 - (b) the waiving of a requirement under the Bylaws,

the Council may issue an order that allows the action, decision or election to be delayed or the requirement to be waived.

- 3. The Council may
 - (a) provide directions with respect to, or
 - (b) impose conditions on

any order made under section (2).

Time Limit on Order under this Bylaw

- 4. An order made under this Emergency Authority Bylaw must not delay an action, decision or election or waive a requirement for a time period that extends beyond the earliest of
 - (a) the date that emergency passes or is resolved; or
 - (b) 180 days.
